COLLEGE AND UNION RULES OF RESIDENCE

1. No student may be absent from college during term time, except Saturday nights, without permission from the appropriate warden.
2. Students are at liberty to leave college on Saturday evenings, but they must leave with the Hostel Representative a forwarding address.
3. All students should return to their hostel by 11.00 p.m. each evening unless a hostel key has been taken and signed for by the student. Each hostel shall be locked at 11.00 p.m. each night.
4. No person may be in a hostel of the opposite sex after 10.45 p.m. each night, except Friday and Saturday when the limit is 12.00 p.m.
5. Students may not leave college for half term or end of term before the time agreed upon by the Co-ordinating committee – usually the end of lecture time on the last day.
6. No unauthorised vehicle is allowed up either the drive to the Principal's House or to the turning circle in the Hostel Area.
7. All vehicles on the campus should be officially registered through the Academic Secretary.
8. There is a 10 m.p.h. speed limit in all car parks and a 20 m.p.h. limit requested on the access road to college.
9. Smoking is prohibited in the Dining-Hall and Gymnasium.
10. Common-Room equipment should not, under any circumstances be removed.
11. Students who do not pay their additional union subscription are not entitled to any of the unions additional facilities as classified at General Union Meeting – June 1968; e.g. membership to any club or society, the right to sit on union committees; the use of common room facilities.

Student Guests.

Students may invite guests to stay in College on Friday and Saturday nights only. The charge is 4/- for one night, 5/- for two nights. Meals if required, should be ordered in advance, whenever possible and paid for at the rate of: Breakfast 2/- Lunch 3/- Supper 3/-. Forms from Domestic Bursar.
